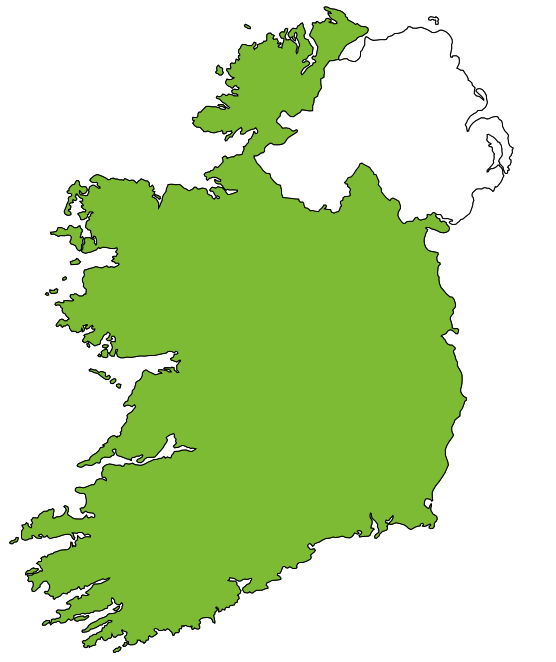


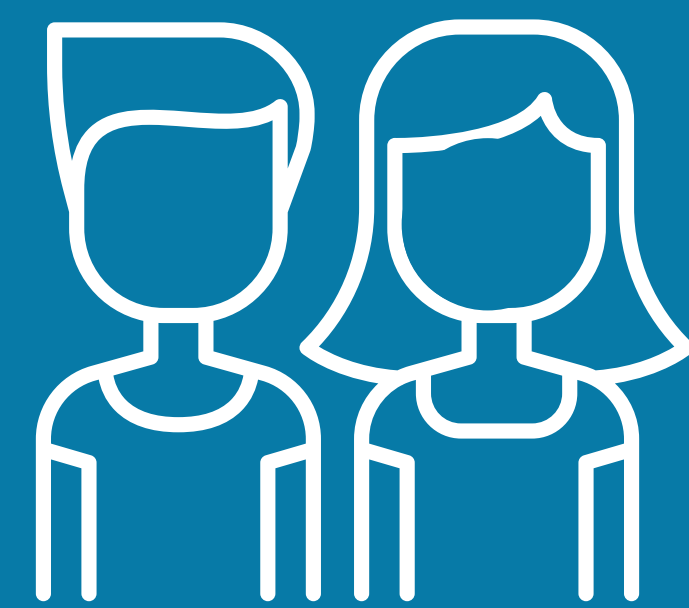

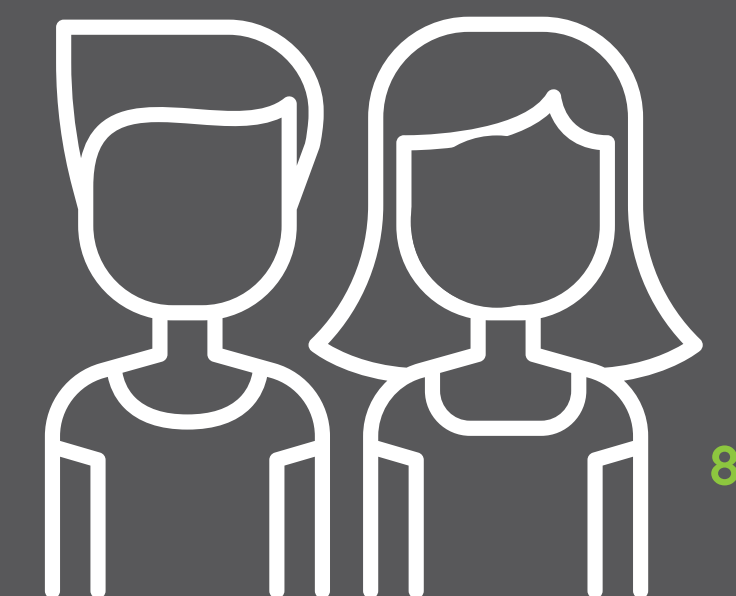
AYAs in Ireland diagnosed with cancer each year



Cancer Incidence

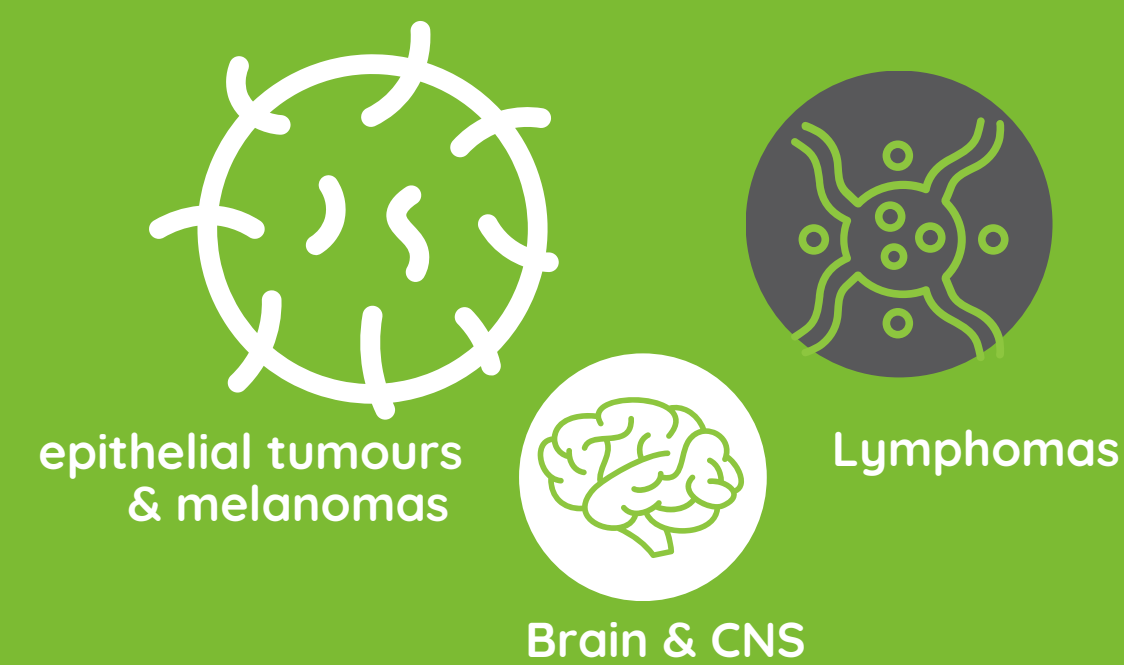
among Irish AYAs is very similar in males & females

90 males per year



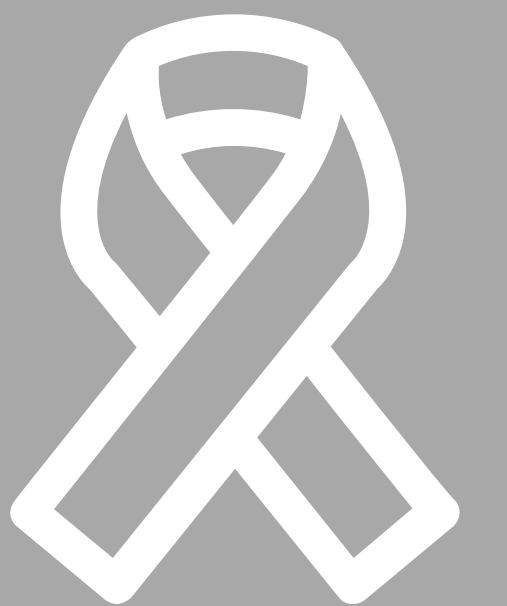
