Blood cancers are cancers that affect your bone marrow and blood cells.

**2400**

New cases  
of blood  
cancers are  
diagnosed  
per year



Blood cancers  
account for  
almost **10%**  
of all new  
cancer cases  
diagnosed  
each year



Death rates  
for blood  
cancers have  
declined  
significantly  
since 2000



Blood cancers  
are responsible  
for over **8%**  
of cancer  
deaths each  
year



5-year survival has  
increased from

**53%** (1994-2007)  
to  
**67%** (2008-2021)



The most common  
blood cancers are  
**non-Hodgkin Lymphoma**  
**Multiple Myeloma**  
**Leukaemia**
