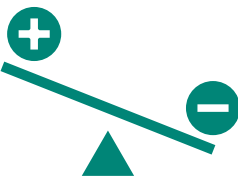
**3,750** tobacco related cancers diagnosed (in 2022)

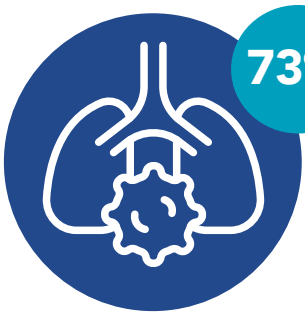
Tobacco smoking accounts for **15%** of all invasive cancers
